The main role of the Farm Accountancy Data Network (FADN) is to support the Common Agricultural Policy (CAP) by determining income of European agricultural holdings and providing farm level analyses based on harmonised micro-economic data collected annually from more than 80 000 farms. The FADN has been established in 1965.

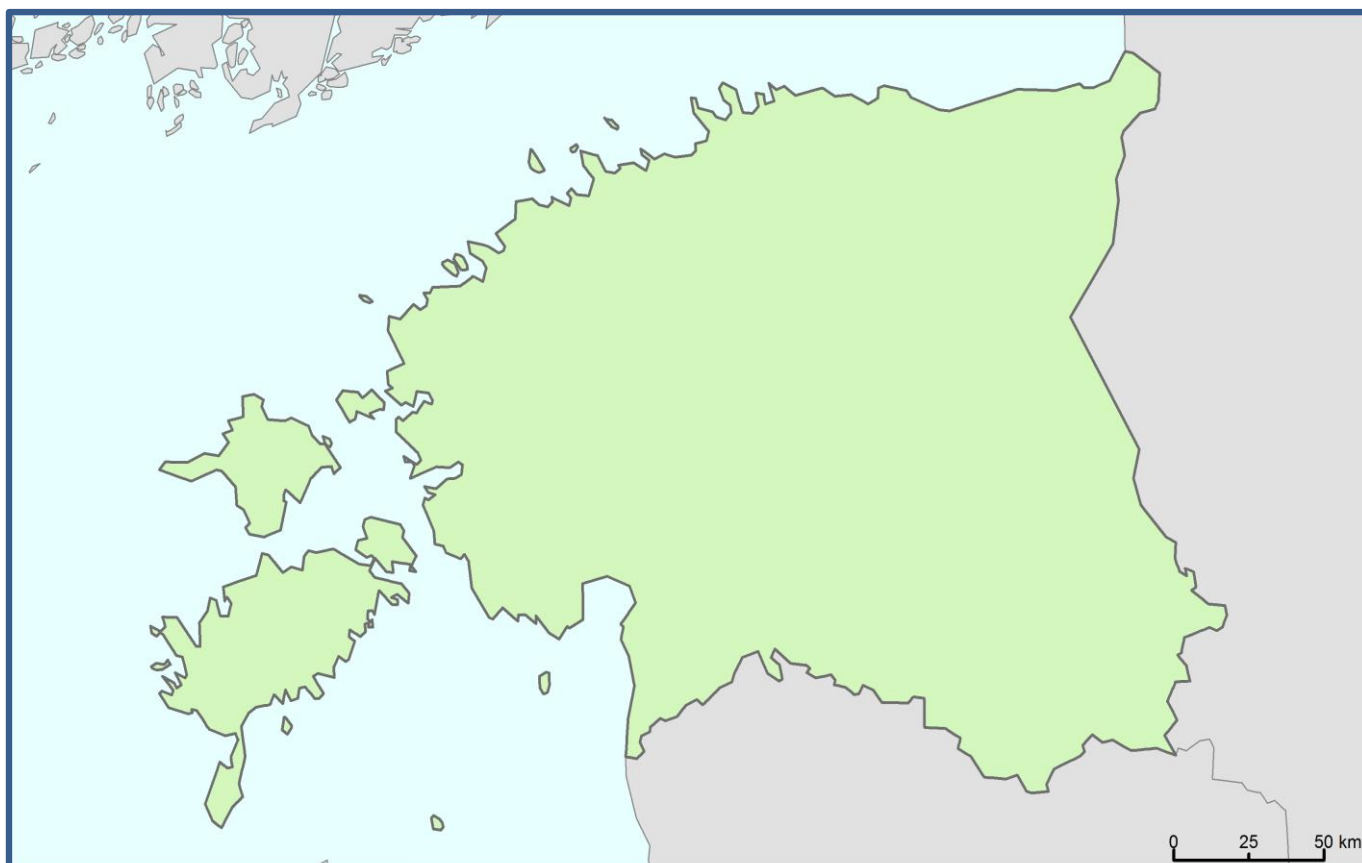

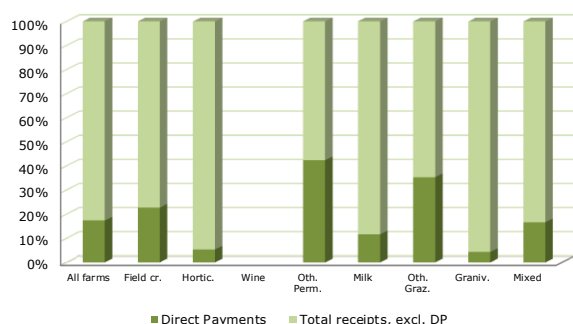

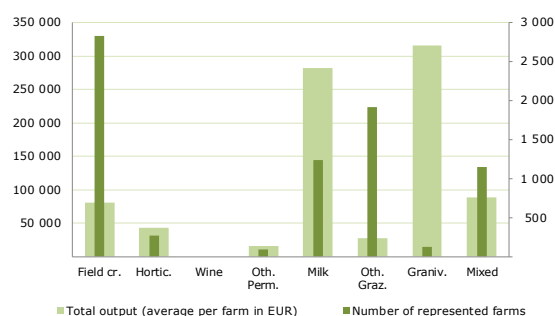
